

2020/21 PARENT/CAREGIVER AGREEMENT FORM

1. For the Centre to run a successful Competition Program for your children, 65 parents are required each week to assist in the smooth running of the Competition for our athletes.
2. It is the Centre policy for all parents joining the Centre to adhere to the following:
 - (a) **All parents, (or nominated adult) are required to volunteer every second week and for the 2020/21 season are required to register their names online and report to their designated event by 7.55am. Athlete family name A-L (A Week) Athlete family name M-Z (B Week)**
 - (b) Children must be under supervision of their parent/caregiver or another designated adult. With the current COVID situation we have a limit to the number of people that can be present at the track. Only 1 parent per family can attend each week. Committee/age managers are exempt from this requirement.
3. Please note on occasions parents may be allocated a duty to manage rather than being able to pick what they want. Parents are required to stay at that event until it is announced that they can pack up. Packing up the event is part of the duty requirement.
4. **If a parent/caregiver doesn't fulfil their roster commitments or organise an alternate make up duty with the committee and their child/children compete on that day, an email will be forwarded by the Centre. This email will state that if this occurs a 2nd time no points or results will apply for the child/children on that day. If there is a third instance athletes will no longer be eligible to participate in the Centre Championships, Centre Multi or receive awards. Therefore, it is important that parents/caregivers ensure roster commitments are met. All roster changes must go through the Officer of Officials phlacofficials@gmail.com.** Please note parents are not expected to do duty if their child is not competing on that day.
5. It is the responsibility of the parent/caregiver to ensure that if their child/children are selected to represent the Centre, they shall do so and the parents/caregivers are required to assist in duties for that particular competition e.g. Zone, Region, State and State Multi.
6. For athletes to be eligible for state gifts and awards, 3 duties must be completed prior to state. (this includes any duty and parents can do make up duties at any time).
7. Parents/Caregivers will abide by the rules set out in the Behavioural Guidelines in the Little Athletics NSW Calendar of Events 2020/2021 and on the website at littleathletics.com.au. For the 2020/21 extra measures will need to be taken at each event including wiping down of equipment after each age group.
8. **If you have any experience in officiating any events with Little Athletics, could you please inform the committee (phlacofficials@gmail.com).**
9. **By signing this form the Parent/Caregiver agrees to assist at Centre Competition every second week and at Special Championships and Events as nominated and applicable.**
